WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

This wine offers an enticing nose with ripe blackberry and black plum, followed by anise, California bay leaf and a hint of dark chocolate. The palate is round and full-bodied, with a long, satisfying finish. The entrance bursts with blackberry, chocolate and a touch of cinnamon stick. The finish is both savory and unique, leaving lingering notes of smoky applewood bacon. Pair with duck breast with cherry compote, pappardelle in a wild boar ragu, or Dubliner cheese. Drink now through 2040.
