WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

This wine opens with inviting aromas of ripe strawberry, leading into lush plum, and finishing with a subtle blend of California bay leaf and black pepper. On the palate, it offers a bold yet elegant body, with a long, smooth finish. The entrance reveals juicy blackberry, followed by a rich mid-palate of dark chocolate. The finish is layered and intriguing, with lingering notes of graphite and a hint of black pepper. Pair with filet mignon in mushroom wine sauce, herb-crusted rack of lamb, or summer ratatouille. Drink now through 2030.
