WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

This Cabernet Sauvignon opens with captivating aromas of violet, rose petal, and a warm hint of cinnamon. The palate is bright and full-bodied, beginning with rich flavors of plum and cocoa, followed by vibrant dark pomegranate. A long, satisfying finish of juicy black cherry completes this elegant and well-balanced wine.

Pair with bone-in ribeye with cremini mushrooms, eggplant Parmesan, or linguini with meatballs and tomato-basil sauce.

Drink now through 2040.
